Irrigation Permit Application Process

1. Submit an Irrigation Plan: Your application must include a detailed irrigation plan that adheres to the city's requirements. This plan should be sealed and signed by a licensed irrigator or landscape architect.

Your irrigation plan should include the following elements:

Dated Seal and Signature: Must be from a licensed irrigator or landscape architect.

Site Features: Include all major physical features and boundaries of the area to be watered (e.g., sidewalks, driveways).

Flow Measurements: Provide the zone flow measurement for each irrigation zone.

Equipment Details: Specify the location and type of controllers, rain and freeze sensors, backflow prevention devices, and water emission devices (e.g., spray heads, drip systems).

Piping and Valves: Include details about main lines, lateral piping, and valves.
